

Waterpolo Years 7-8, 2021

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Please find below information on Term 1-4 Waterpolo for Year 7 & Year 8 players.

Players must be able to swim in a deep water pool, and confidently complete a 50 metre swim on both their front & back. They must also be able to tread water for longer than 5 minutes at a time. If students are registered for Waterpolo, and the coaches at NH Waterpolo determine at the first trainings / trials that they are unable to meet the above requirements, the student will be removed from the pool for safety reasons.

Please also note that due to the structure of the league, the commitment to Waterpolo in 2021 is for the whole year (Terms 1-4). Fees will be charged every 2 terms.

Please note – a minimum number of players will be required in order for a team to be entered into the league. Confirmation will be provided after the registration close date.

Dates:	Trainings ONLY commence Term 1, Week 3, 2021 Games (additional to trainings) commence Term 2, 2021
Practice Day & Time Term 1:	Friday 3:30pm – 4:30pm
Practice Day Term 2-4:	TBC (either Monday or Wednesday)
Game Day commencing Term 2:	Friday
Game Times:	Vary 4:00pm – 8:00pm
Equipment and Uniform:	Suitable swimwear for games & practices. Students to bring towel/drink bottle. Playing caps provided.
Team Placements:	Trials will be held (if registration numbers require) over the first 3 weeks of trainings. Students will be put in teams based on the recommendation of professional coaches provided by NHW.
Cost:	\$ 480.00 per player (4 terms) + uniform (additional cost) <i>\$ 240.00 (Term 1&2 – charged to your account Term 1)</i> <i>\$ 240.00 (Term 3&4 – charged to your account Term 3)</i>
Coach & Manager:	Each team will require a coach & manager to assist the team throughout the season. A requirement of the league is for teams to be conversant with Table duties. Each team will be rostered on duty.
Registration:	Registrations close 9am, Tuesday 9th February 2021 Click here to register
