New Cases

We have had two new cases in the past 24 hours.

A Year 8 student tested positive at home this morning. She was already isolating because her little sister (who doesn't go to our school) tested positive earlier in the week, and so she will not have been infectious in school. She has mild symptoms.

A Year 6 student tested positive at home this morning. She had some symptoms this morning, and is already feeling a little better. She was in school yesterday and Tuesday, so she may have been infectious while she was at school. We tested all Year 6 students as soon as we found out this morning. All tests were negative. Can I ask parents of Year 6 students to be particularly vigilant for any possible symptoms in your children this week?

Many thanks to both families for their promptness in letting the school know, and our very best wishes to both the children and their families.

Rapid Antigen Testing

We tested a small number of returning students this morning. We also tested all Year 6 students. All tests were negative.
